This means that if both parties are members of an Eastern Catholic Church or only one is a member of it and the other one is a non-Catholic (mixed marriage or disparity of cult), the Latin local Ordinary or the parish priest must request and be granted the delegation from the competent Eastern hierarch or pastor to assist validly at the marriage
